3. Submit the completed Refrigeration Equipment Tune-Up Incentive Application to Focus on Energy, postmarked no later than September 30, 2009.



Participants in the 2008 Pilot Commercial Refrigeration Preventive Maintenance Program are not eligible. To qualify for the incentives, service must be completed **between April 15, 2009 and September 30, 2009**.
