A Focus on Energy account representative will contact you within two weeks to facilitate the actuation of each project.

## **ELIGIBILITY / REQUIREMENTS / INCENTIVES:**

### ***New, single-family***

- Incentive/grant - \$2,500 per unit with a maximum of \$15,000 per organization
- Organization must have a 501(c)3 IRS or local unit of government status. Organization must demonstrate future occupants will meet end-user income requirement of 80% of county median income.
- Verification of Wisconsin ENERGY STAR Homes certification.
- Project(s) is/are in a participating Focus utility.
- Complete Focus Market Provider Agreement and an Affordable Housing Application.
- Verification of Focus education seminar/training or on-site individualized training by a program consultant.

### ***Existing, single-family, major rehab***

- Incentive/grant - \$3,000 per unit with a maximum of \$15,000 per organization. Maximum incentive does not apply when related to Neighborhood Stabilization Program grant
- Organization must have a 501(c)3 IRS or local unit of government status. Organization must demonstrate future occupants will meet end-user income requirement of 80% of county median income.
- Project must be in the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program with performance targets: 1) air tightness limit – .35 cfm/sq ft shell area@50pascals; 2) ventilation – ASHRAE 62.2; 3) design for and attain a score of 80 on the Home Energy Rating System (HERS) index. (Note: This will require hiring a Home Performance with ENERGY STAR consultant).
- Project(s) is/are in a participating Focus utility.
- Complete Focus Market Provider Agreement and an Affordable Housing Application.
- Verification of Focus education seminar/training or on-site individualized training by a program consultant.

### ***Congregate living***

- Organization must have a 501(c)3 IRS or local unit of governmental status. Organization must have ownership of project.
- Incentive: \$3,000 per unit, \$15,000 maximum per organization
- Project could be an emergency shelter, transitional housing, or homeless prevention program as determined by the Department of Commerce.
- The type of housing must be of the single-family residential type. Other types of housing will be considered on a case-by-case basis or referred to the appropriate program area.
- No cost direct install of shower heads, CFLs bulbs, and an energy audit. Installation of three (3) measures from the energy audit, one of which must be an air sealing measure.
- Project(s) is/are in a participating Focus utility.
- Complete Focus Market Provider Agreement and an Affordable Housing Application.
- Verification of required Focus education seminar/training.

**Existing, single-family, mortgage (Available only through Select Milwaukee at this time 2.1.09)**

- Incentive/Grant - \$3,000.
- Project owner meets 80% of county median income requirement.
- Owner must obtain a loan through Select Milwaukee.
- Installation of all measures from the energy audit, as determined by a Home Performance with ENERGY STAR consultant.
- Project(s) is/are in a participating Focus utility and sign a market provider agreement.
